*The Project SEARCH High School Transition Program is a unique, business led, one year school-to-work program that takes place entirely at RRMCM. Total workplace immersion facilitates a seamless combination of classroom instruction, career exploration, and hands-on training through worksite rotations.*

*The program begins with two weeks of instruction before internships commence. In addition to the three 10-week internships in various departments at RRMCM, students work on curriculum focused on employment and independent living skills. The transferrable skills that students learn will assist in the goal of securing full or part time employment.*

*The program follows the school calendar, beginning on the same day as area high schools. The program concludes in June prior to high school graduation dates.*
